(Melissa put together a PP for RCA)</li> <li>• Potential spring programming- I have connected with SCYAP Art Centre and their project manager is very willing to set up some riversdale programming in the near future. She said it was \$100/session and they could do 4 to 6 weeks. And they were very flexible on what the programming could be.</li> <li>• Makerspace would be willing to do some programming. - **Riversdale Winter Festival**

-Sunday March 12

- I emailed Kat Stone as per the email from Alicia, but have yet to hear back.

-Do we want to think of a better name? Something really catchy and snazzy? **\*Getting Slick at Vic Riversdale Winter Festival.** (Haley, you can use this if you'd like!)

-I know lots can change before March 12, but with the warm weather cross country skiing might not be great, and as there are no groomed trails this year...do we want to do another activity with the allotted \$500? **-snowshoeing; Coloured water into squirt bottles to make pictures in snow; snowman building (carrots, buttons, toques / scarfs to be donated later); winter hopscotch/tic tac toe with coloured water (Amanda volunteers!); schlocky (big shuffle board with hockey sticks-it happened at winterruption); Bannock around the stick around the fires. Alicia will see if there is a tipi.**

-If we do make changes to our budget I must let the city know sooner rather than later.

-Special Events Application is submitted and approved.

**-I need a cheque written to myself for \$31.50 (the cost of the application fee).**

- **Riversdale Soccer League**

-Will accommodate 80 children from the ages of 4 - 12

-I will use my contact at Tim Horton's (thanks to my sister-in-law//restaurant owner who hooked this up!) to get the kids jerseys, soccer balls, and medals at the end of the season

-I am making this motion because I need to get registration started sooner than later (ordering From Tim Horton's, emailing families - this is a huge undertaking for me as last year we had 40 kids and I spent hours answering emails from parents, it will be double and I am scared...)

• **Winter 2023 Youth Grant - MakerSpace Workshop**

-Dan can fill everyone in on the event as he attended.  
-Of the 9 youth that participated, 3 families did the follow up feedback and they all had positive reviews - happy to share with anyone who's interested :)  
-2 of the 9 youth were from Riversdale the rest were from outside communities (Varsity View, Caswell, Westmount, Mayfair) - how do we recruit more Riversdale youth? King George School's "dream broker" signed up 5 youth but they no-showed.  
-MakerSpace was thrilled with the event and proposed to do this monthly - \$400 per workshop for 10 youth (\$40/participant) - Kaley will explain more. Dakota: maybe do a deposit for a spot?  
-Youth Grant Follow Up Report DONE - Emailed to Alicia today.
